



DANCE SCHOLARSHIP CONTRACT

Upon acceptance of a scholarship, students and their parents (if student is under the age of 18) are required to sign and commit to the School of Missouri Contemporary Ballet scholarship contract.

EXPECTATIONS FOR SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS

1. **DEDICATION AND COMMITMENT TO HARD WORK:** Work hard in every class and make a consistent effort toward improvement
2. **COMMITMENT TO PROFESSIONALISM:** As an ambassador of the School of Missouri Contemporary Ballet, it is important that you conduct yourself in a professional manner.
3. **MANDATORY ATTENDANCE:** Prior notification and School of MCB director approval is required for any missed classes and rehearsals due to extenuation circumstances such as illness, school event or family emergency.
4. **COMMITMENT TO THE SCHOOL OF MCB:**
 - a. Enrollment in the School of MCB is required for the entire year in order to receive a scholarship
 - b. Scholarship recipients may not be enrolled at any other place of ballet training. Your enrollment at School of MCB must take over other athletic/artistic interests.
 - c. Participation in all School of MCB performances (including participation in Performance Company if eligible)
5. **COMPLETION OF ALL ASSIGNED DUTIES:** Scholarship recipients will be held personally responsible for completing their assigned jobs in a timely manner.
6. **PARTICIPATION IN ALL SCHOOL OF MCB FUNDRAISERS**
